The owner obtained this dog from a Breeder under conditions such that particulars of age, breeding, registration are known or a Rescue Centre that has provided all known information. The owner has stated that they are the current owner and are fully able to sanction this Agreement. The owner is of the opinion that the dog has a temperament & personality suitable for a family pet and companion if provided good training and handling. The owner will at their convenience provide such advice or counseling as Canine Assist may request to deal with any problems of adjustment and training.

Transfer of care for the dog for the period detailed is in consideration of the following promises by Canine Assist & the Owner. These promises are material and are the essence of the transfer.

Canine Assist promise: to RESPECT the dog and to TRAIN the dog in basic OBEDIENCE (should the owner request – see dog camp).

The owner will supply Canine Assist with adequate food/treats, bedding/crating so that the dog is comfortable - with any costs incurred by Canine Assist in relation to this being fully reimbursed on collection of the Dog

Canine Assist promises to CARE FOR the dog in SICKNESS and in HEALTH providing adequate veterinary care (Ark Veterinary Clinic – Long Eaton). Should the dog become ill/injured whilst in our care Canine Assist will make the appropriate decision for the dog following veterinary advice; and any expense incurred by Canine Assist will be fully reimbursed on collection of the Dog up to and including Destruction.

Canine Assist promise that the dog shall live in the house as a MEMBER OF THE FAMILY. Canine Assist promise to CHERISH and PROTECT the dog until collection. Canine Assist promise to EXERCISE the dog, NOURISH the dog and ENTERTAIN the dog.

Canine Assist will at the owners request take the dog out for walks – the owner will instruct Canine Assist as to whether the dog is to be allowed off lead (Yes/No) the owner also will instruct Canine Assist as to whether the dog is permitted to be socialized with other dogs (Yes/No), The owner accepts that in the event that their dog comes into contact with another dog and there is a subsequent incident leading to a fight/bite that no subsequent claim can be made against Canine Assist in return Canine Assist promise to observe the dog whilst out and minimize the possibilities of any such incidents through their knowledge and training.

Canine Assist take every possible precaution to prevent fights/bites etc, however due to the nature of animal behaviour this is not always possible and should your dog sustain or instigate a bite/fight then you accept that no claim can be made against Canine Assist Providing Adequate medical attention and care was given along with the introduction of suitable separation protocols to prevent re-occurrence.

The client further agrees that if their dog attacks, or is involved in a fight with another dog, (and/or person) causing injury to that dog (or person) they will be responsible for any losses incurred as a result including, but not limited to, payment of veterinary fees in respect of injuries to another animal caused by their dog. Canine Assist strongly advise that all Dogs have insurance for such eventualities.

If your dog becomes unwell, is injured or has an accident during his stay Canine Assist will take them to a Veterinary Surgery (Ark Veterinary Clinic – Long Eaton). You Agree to be responsible for payment of veterinary fees incurred upon your return. We do strongly recommend that your dog is insured against sickness, accident, injury and third party liability. This contract gives Canine Assist authorisation to take your dog/s to the vets if necessary, whilst also confirming you will either reimburse Canine Assist or the Veterinary Surgery direct in full, whichever applies.

In the event of an overstay for whatever reason; Canine Assist should be contacted immediately. Canine Assist reserve the right to charge up to £45 per night (24 hr Period) for overstays (due to loss of business and breach if licensing agreement with regards to number of dogs).

Aggressive dogs may be accepted however there is an additional charge of £20 per night – This additional charge represents the additional time required to manage the stay and also the loss of business for closing the hotel for the period of the aggressive dog stay. In these cases the dog may have to be re-located to a kennel – any cost incurred by Canine Assist will be reimbursed by the Owner on collection of the dog.

If Canine Assist Doggie Day Care/Hotel feel that the one-hour assessment has not been sufficient we might ask for a longer assessment of 1/2 day-1 day, at the clients expense
